

ORDER

**EMERGENCY PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY CLOSURE
COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551, 36 CFR § 261.50(a), and 36 CFR § 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Coconino National Forest, in the following county, Coconino. The restricted area is depicted in the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as **Exhibit A*** within the Coconino National Forest.

PROHIBITIONS:

- 1. Going into or being upon the restricted area; 36 CFR § 261.53(e).**

AREA DESCRIPTION:

This Order affects the Kachina Peaks Wilderness area on the Peaks Ranger District of the Coconino National Forest.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this closure order:

Any Federal, State or Local Officer or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This order is necessary to protect the public health and safety from avalanche danger.

This order becomes effective at 4:00 PM, January 22, 2010, and will remain in force until rescinded. This Order rescinds, replaces and supercedes any previous order.

Violations of these regulations is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both; 16 USC § 551, and 18 USC §§ 3559 and 3571.
